About UNHCR

- The United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) is a United Nations agency mandated to aid and protect refugees, forcibly displaced communities, and stateless people, and to assist in their voluntary repatriation, local integration or resettlement to a third country.
- It is headquartered in Geneva, Switzerland.
- UNHCR was created in 1950 to address the refugee crisis that resulted from World War II.
- The 1951 Refugee Convention established the scope and legal framework of the agency's work, which initially focused on Europeans uprooted by the war.

India-ASEAN to rejig 15-year trade pact in early 2024



Context

- India and the ten-member Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN) will begin negotiations to "modernise" their decade-and-a-half-old free trade agreement (FTA) to bring more balance in the pact currently weighed against New Delhi.
- New areas like labour, environment, Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) and gender, are likely to be kept out.
- India has long been pressing for a review of the ASEAN India Trade in Goods Agreement (AITGA), which was signed in August 2009, as the pact resulted in disproportionate benefits for the ASEAN.

The 10-member ASEAN region accounted for 11.3% of India's global trade in 2022-23

 The Association of Southeast Asian Nations is a regional organization which was established to promote political and social stability amid rising tensions among the Asia-Pacific's post-colonial states.

About Tea Board of India It is a statutory body under the Ministry of Commerce that was set up in 1953 for the development of tea industry in India. It started functioning in 1954. Its vision and mission is to make the country a leading producer of tea across the globe for which it established several programmes and schemes. The Board is constituted of 31 members (including Chairman) drawn from Members of Parliament, tea producers, tea traders, tea brokers, consumers, and representatives of Governments from the principal tea producing states, and trade unions The Board is reconstituted every three years. The board has its headquarters located in Kolkata

Two jumping spider species discovered from Kerala



Context:

- A team of researchers from Kerala and Tamil Nadu have discovered two new species of jumping spiders that belong to the genus Afraflacilla.
- Only three species belonging to the genus had been hitherto discovered in the country.
- Specimens of Afraflacilla kerala were spotted in Kuttanad and Irinjalakuda by researchers Nishi Babu of Kerala University and Rishikesh Tripathi of Christ College, Irinjalakuda
- Specimens of Afraflacilla TN were spotted by M.
 Sampathkumar from Adavathur in Tiruchirappalli.

Wayanad to host State-level 'Vayanolsavam'



Context:

- A First ever State-level 'Vayanolsavam' (reading festival) is to be organized by the Kerala State Library Council
- It will be held at the M.S. Swaminathan Research Foundation Auditorium at Puthurvayal.

About:

- Vayanolsavam, meaning "Reading Festival," is a vibrant celebration of literature and books held annually in Kerala
- This festival aims to cultivate a love for reading and foster a culture of knowledge in the state.
- It was initiated in 1990 by the Kerala State Library Department

- All the services will be provided online using K-SMART (Kerala Solutions For Managing Administrative Reformation and Transformation) software
- K-SMART is developed for local self government institutions by the Information Kerala Mission.

Aranmula Kannadi



Context:

- The Aranmula Kannadi is a unique metal mirror handcrafted in the village of Aranmula in Kerala,
- It is made from a special alloy of copper and tin, creating a distinct reflective surface that is said to be distortion-free and capture the true essence of the person looking into it.
- It is crafted entirely by hand using a centuries-old technique passed down through generations of Vishwakarma families.
- It is associated with the Aranmula Parthasarathy Temple, where the first Aranmula Kannadi was gifted to the presiding deity.
