• Earth day is dedicated to demonstrating support for environmental protection.

About World Earth Day 2024:

- Date: Earth Day will be observed on April 22, 2024.
- Theme: The theme for 2024 is "Planet vs. Plastics", focusing on reducing plastic pollution and its impact on human and environmental health.
- Goals: The aims include a 60% reduction in plastic production by 2040, phasing out single-use plastics by 2030, and promoting innovative technologies for a plastic-free future.
- Negotiations: Concurrent with Earth Day, the fourth round of negotiations for the United Nations Global Plastic Treaty will take place, aiming for stringent commitments against plastic pollution.

Global Financial Stability Report 2024

Why in news?

- The International Monetary Fund (IMF) released the latest global financial stability report.
- The report warns about **risks to the global financial** system from several factors:
 - Persistent high inflation
 - Rising lending in the unregulated credit market
 - Increasing cyber-attacks on financial institutions.

Key points of report:

- Geopolitical risks, such as the ongoing war in West Asia and Ukraine, could affect aggregate supply and lead to higher prices. This might prevent central banks from lowering rates in the near future.
- In 2023, India was the second-largest recipient of foreign capital after the U.S. However, this could change quickly if western central banks indicate that they



	 Control: The crossing is controlled by Egypt, following an agreement with Israel made in 2007.

- It is a **DNA virus**.
- Cause: Mpox is caused by the monkeypox virus, which
 is a member of the Orthopoxvirus genus in the family
 Poxviridae.
- Transmission: The virus can spread from person to person through close contact with respiratory secretions, skin lesions of an infected person, or recently contaminated objects. Transmission can also occur via droplets during prolonged face-to-face contact.
- Vaccination: Vaccines used for smallpox such as the JYNNEOS (also known as Imvamune or Imvanex) vaccine are effective against Mpox.



Kavach, the anti-collision system

HOW RAILWAYS' KAVACH PROTECTION SYSTEM WORKS

KPS is a set of electronic and radio frequency devices installed in



Why in news?

- Southern Railway has decided to install Kavach, an anti-collision system for trains.
- The system will be installed for 2,216 km of tracks across Tamil Nadu and Kerala.

Key Kavach:

- Kavach System Overview: Developed by the Indian Railways Research Designs and Organisation (RDSO), Kavach is a cab signalling and train control system with anti-collision features.
- Functionality: It alerts the loco pilot if a 'red signal' is unnoticed and the train is at risk of overshooting the signal.
- Warnings and Automatic Actions: The system provides warnings on the loco pilot's display and will automatically apply brakes if the train does not slow to below 15 kilometers per hour, thereby stopping the train to prevent accidents.

One Health initiative

Why in news?

- The **Health department**, **Kerala** is preparing to release detailed Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for the outbreak investigation and control of at least eight diseases as part of the One Health initiative.
- This is the first time that state-level guidelines for infectious diseases outbreak investigation are being prepared on the One Health platform.

Key points:

- The SOPs cover a range of diseases including
 - water-borne diseases (like acute diarrhoeal diseases, Hepatitis A and E),
 - food-borne infections.
 - mosquito-borne diseases (like dengue, chikungunya, and zika),
 - Encephalitis Syndrome (Japanese encephalitis and West Nile fever),

Codex Committee on Spices and Culinary Herbs (CCSCH)	Why in news? The 7th Session of the Codex Committee on Spices and Culinary Herbs (CCSCH) took place recently. The session was held in Kochi.
	 Key points: During the session, the committee finalised and recommended quality standards for five spices. The spices for which standards were finalised are Allspice, Juniper berries, Star anise, Turmeric, and Cardamom.
	 About Codex Committee on Spices and Culinary Herbs (CCSCH): The CCSCH is an international body that strives to create global standards for spices and culinary herbs. The CCSCH was established in 2013 by the Codex Alimentarius Commission, which is a joint venture of the World Health Organization (WHO) and the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United
