
















Campus Industrial programme	Park	<ul> <li>Why in news? <ul> <li>18 educational institutions in Kochi have shown interest in joining the Campus Industrial Park programme initiated by the Kerala state government.</li> </ul> </li> <li>About Campus Industrial Park programme: <ul> <li>The programme is designed to encourage entrepreneurship among students and to strengthen the industry-academia collaboration.</li> <li>It aims to make use of the unutilised land within educational institutions for industrial purposes.</li> <li>Educational institutions owning a minimum of five acres of land can develop industrial parks, and those having a minimum of two acres can develop standard design factories.</li> <li>The government will extend financial support towards building infrastructure facilities such as electricity, water, road, drainage, ETP/CETP, and common facilities like laboratory, testing, and certification facilities.</li> <li>A separate Single Window Clearance Board will be formed for each Campus Industrial Park.</li> <li>Genrobotics, a pioneer in robotics, had recently launched the State's first industrial park on campus at Ilahia College of Engineering and Technology, Muvattupuzha.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Conducting elections to the local bodies and dealing with all matters pertaining to these elections, including scheduling and logistic arrangements.</li> </ul>

	About Kathakali:	
	Origin and History: Kathakali originated in the 17th century	
	in Kerala. It evolved from older temple and folk arts,	
	incorporating elements from various dance forms like	
	Krishnattam and Ramanattam.	
	Meaning of Name: The word "Kathakali" translates to	
	"Story Play" in Malayalam, reflecting its emphasis on	
	storytelling through dance.	
	Character Types: Characters in Kathakali are categorized into	
	several types, such as <b>"Pacha" (green) for heroic or</b>	
	virtuous characters, "Kathi" (knife) for villains, and	
	"Minukku" for females and saints.	
	Performance: A typical performance involves actors	
	portraying scenes from Hindu epics like the Ramayana	
	and the Mahabharata.	
	Music and Instruments: The music of Kathakali is distinct and	
	is provided by singers who narrate the story along with	
	traditional instruments like the chenda (drum), maddalam	
	(double-headed drum), and the edakka.
