Navakiranam project	<ul> <li>Why in the news?</li> <li>The 'Navakiranam' voluntary relocation scheme has encountered a roadblock due to a shortage of funds in the Forest department.</li> <li>Despite this, the scheme has successfully relocated 784 non-tribal families to areas adjoining the forests.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>About Navakiranam project: <ul> <li>Objective:</li> <li>The Navakiranam voluntary relocation scheme was initiated by the Kerala government under the Rebuild Kerala Initiative.</li> <li>Its primary goal is to relocate people residing in isolated forest settlements who face threats from wild animal attacks and landslides.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Target Group: Families residing in areas prone to natural disasters or those living in biodiversity-rich zones where human habitation poses a threat to the environment.</li> <li>Incentives: <ul> <li>Financial compensation, land allocation, and support for building new homes in the designated relocation areas.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- **Objective**: • The Jeevanandam scheme offers government employees the option to
  - invest a desired amount. • It guarantees a fixed monthly income
  - post-retirement through the State Insurance Department.
  - Implementation: • The project **deducts a fixed amount** monthly from the salary of government employees.
    - In return, it provides a fixed monthly amount once the employees retire.
  - Not Mandatory: • The scheme is not mandatory; **employees** can choose to participate.
    - The government aims to ensure insurance coverage and financial security for retirees.
