Definition: It defines 'headload work' as the manual labor of carrying goods for hire or reward. Registration: Provides for the registration of headload workers with the Licensing Authority. Welfare Measures: Includes provisions for the welfare of headload workers, such as ensuring proper working conditions and timely payment. Regulation: Empowers the Licensing Authority to regulate recruitment, employment, and wages of headload workers. |

| National Health Mission (NHM) | Why in the news? The Health Minister of Kerala has urgently appealed to the Union Health Minister to release ₹637 crore earmarked for the National Health Mission (NHM) activities in Kerala for the fiscal year 2023-24. About NHM: Objective: NHM was launched with the aim to provide accessible, affordable, and quality healthcare to rural populations, especially mothers and children. Launch Date: NHM was launched in May 2013, replacing the earlier National Rural Health Mission (NRHM). Components: It integrates various national health programs like Reproductive, Maternal, Newborn, Child and Adolescent Health (RMNCH+A), National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme (NVBDCP), etc. Sub-missions: National Rural Health Mission (NRHM), National Urban Health Mission (NUHM), and various state health missions. Focus Areas: Key areas of focus include maternal and child health, immunization, communicable diseases control, non-communicable diseases, sanitation, hygiene, etc. Implementation: Implemented by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, in collaboration with state governments. Funding: NHM is primarily funded by the Government of India, with state contributions, and also receives |
| | support from external agencies and partnerships. |
