Mahabodhi Temple Complex	<ul> <li>Why in the news?</li> <li>Satellite images suggest architectural wealth beneath Mahabodhi temple in Bodh Gaya.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>About Mahabodhi Temple Complex:</li> <li>Significance: One of the four holy sites related to Lord Buddha's life, marking the spot of his Enlightenment.</li> <li>Location: Bodh Gaya, central Bihar, on the banks of the Niranjana River.</li> <li>Historical Importance: <ul> <li>First temple built by Emperor Ashoka in the 3rd century B.C.</li> <li>Present temple dates from the 5th or 6th centuries.</li> <li>Surviving example of early brick structures from the late Gupta period.</li> <li>Influential in the development of brick architecture.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Architecture: <ul> <li>Grand temple's pyramidal shikhara (tower) with layers of niches, arch motifs, and fine engravings.</li> <li>Four smaller identical towers at the corners, topped with umbrella-like domes.</li> <li>Yellow sandstone statue of the Buddha inside the shrine.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Supposed direct descendant of the original Bodhi Tree where Buddha attained enlightenment.</li> <li>Ashoka's stone slab marks the exact spot of Buddha's enlightenment, known as Buddha's vajrasana ("diamond throne" or "thunder seat").</li> <li>UNESCO World Heritage Site: Recognized in 2002.</li> </ul>

Crew Health and Performance Exploration Analog (CHAPEA) project	<ul> <li>Why in the news?</li> <li>A NASA crew has emerged from a year-long simulated Mars mission as part of the CHAPEA project, which took place in a 17,000 sq ft habitat at Johnson Space Center.</li> <li>About CHAPEA project: <ul> <li>Purpose: Simulate year-long stays on Mars to assess NASA's food system and physical and behavioral health in humans for future space missions.</li> <li>Features: <ul> <li>Four private crew quarters</li> <li>Dedicated workstations</li> <li>Galley and food-growing stations</li> </ul> </li> <li>Mission Environment: Simulates realistic Mars conditions with environmental stressors such as: <ul> <li>Resource limitations</li> <li>Isolation</li> <li>Conduct simulated spacewalks.</li> <li>Provide data on physical and behavioral health and performance.</li> </ul> </li> </ul></li></ul>
