Resettlement: Five-member panel to assess preps in Wayanad	 Why in news? Recently, a Cabinet sub-committee members K Rajan, P A Mohamed Riyas, A K Saseendran and O R Kelu , a five-member committee headed by Wayanad District Collector D R Meghashree has been formed to assess the arrangements for temporary rehabilitation.
	 Key Points: The Wayanad district of Kerala has witnessed one of the most devastating landslide-related disasters due to extreme rainfall and fragile ecological conditions. A landslide is the downward movement of rock, soil, and debris on a slope, ranging from small shifts to large, destructive events. It can occur on natural or man-made slopes and is triggered by factors like heavy rainfall, earthquakes, volcanic activity, human activities, and changes in groundwater levels.
Mettukurinji blooms	 Why in news? Recently, Idukki hills in Kerala turn blue as rare Mettukurinji blooms in the district.
	 Key Points: Mettukurinji blooms every seven years at an elevation of 600 to 1000 meters above sea level. It is a rare species of Kurinji, the Strobilanthes sessilis variety that bursts into bloom. Mettukurinji blooms are also present in Parunthumpara hills.
Awards & Honors: State Kayakalp awards	 Why in news? Recently, the State Health Department has announced the Kayakalp Award for 2023-24, recognising government health institutions that excel in cleanliness, waste management, and infection control.

	 Key Points: The seven thematic areas include: 'A' - Hospital/Facility Upkeep, 'B' - Sanitation & Hygiene, 'C'- Waste Management, 'd' - Infection Control, 'E' - Support Services, and 'F' - Hygiene Promotion. It is an extension of the Swachh Bharat Mission in India.
PM Gati Shakti	 Why in news? The South Zone district-level capacity building workshop for the PM Gati Shakti (PMGS) project, which focuses on integrated infrastructure planning, is being held. It will include participants from various districts across five southern states.
	 Key Points: PM Gati Shakti (launched in 2021) is a National Master Plan for multi-modal connectivity that will incorporate the infrastructure schemes of various Ministries and State Governments like Bharatmala, Sagarmala, inland waterways, dry/land ports, UDAN etc. Under the programme, 100 critical infrastructure gap projects have been prioritized in FY24 for development with a budgetary allocation of Rs. 75,000 crores.
Species in news: Dancing Frog	 Why in news? Kallar dancing frog was found in Ranni forest division. Key Points: The dancing frogs that are endemic to the Western Ghats are the most threatened amphibian genus of India. They are specifically from the Micrixalus genus, a group of frogs. Dancing frogs exhibit a unique mating behavior characterized by foot flagging, where males extend their hind legs and wave their webbed toes.
