	<ul> <li>Key Points:</li> <li>The Wayanad district of Kerala has witnessed one of the most devastating landslide-related disasters due to extreme rainfall and fragile ecological conditions.</li> <li>A landslide is the downward movement of rock, soil, and debris on a slope, ranging from small shifts to large, destructive events.</li> <li>It can occur on natural or man-made slopes and is triggered by factors like heavy rainfall, earthquakes, volcanic activity, human activities, and changes in groundwater levels.</li> </ul>
Mettukurinji blooms	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>Recently, Idukki hills in Kerala turn blue as rare Mettukurinji blooms in the district.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Key Points:</li> <li>Mettukurinji blooms every seven years at an elevation of 600 to 1000 meters above sea level.</li> <li>It is a rare species of Kurinji, the Strobilanthes sessilis variety that bursts into bloom.</li> <li>Mettukurinji blooms are also present in Parunthumpara hills.</li> </ul>
Awards & Honors: State Kayakalp awards	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>Recently, the State Health Department has announced the Kayakalp Award for 2023-24, recognising government health institutions that excel in cleanliness, waste management, and infection control.</li> </ul>

PM Gati Shakti	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>The South Zone district-level capacity building workshop for the PM Gati Shakti (PMGS) project, which focuses on integrated infrastructure planning, is being held.</li> <li>It will include participants from various districts across five southern states.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Key Points:         <ul> <li>PM Gati Shakti (launched in 2021) is a National Master Plan for multi-modal connectivity that will incorporate the infrastructure schemes of various Ministries and State Governments like Bharatmala, Sagarmala, inland waterways, dry/land ports, UDAN etc.</li> <li>Under the programme, 100 critical infrastructure gap projects have been prioritized in FY24 for development with a budgetary allocation of Rs. 75,000 crores.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Species in news: Dancing Frog	<ul> <li>Why in news? <ul> <li>Kallar dancing frog was found in Ranni forest division.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Key Points: <ul> <li>The dancing frogs that are endemic to the Western Ghats are the most threatened amphibian genus of India.</li> <li>They are specifically from the Micrixalus genus, a group of frogs.</li> <li>Dancing frogs exhibit a unique mating behavior characterized by foot flagging, where males extend their hind legs and wave their webbed toes.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
