Person in news: Justice Anil Kumar	 Why in the news? Recently, former High Court judge, Justice N Anil Kumar has been appointed as the sixth LokAyukta of Kerala. Key Points: The Lokayukta is the Indian Parliamentary Ombudsman, executed into power, through and for, each of the State Governments of India. It is an anti-corruption authority. The object of the Lokayukta system in a state is to investigate grievances, allegations against public servants.
Methanol as fuel	 Why in the news? The Rajiv Gandhi Combined Cycle Power Project (RGCCPP), Kayamkulam, a unit of the National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) has signed an agreement with the Bharath Heavy Electrical Limited (BHEL) to generate electricity from methanol. Key Points: It appears as a colorless fairly volatile liquid with a faintly sweet pungent odor like that of ethyl alcohol. It is also known as wood alcohol. It can completely mix with water. Production: Preparing methanol is based on the direct combination of carbon monoxide gas and hydrogen in the presence of a catalyst. Increasingly, syngas, a mixture of hydrogen and carbon monoxide derived from biomass, is used for methanol production.
Lakshadweep islands	 Why in the news? Marine scientists from Kerala University of Fisheries and Ocean Studies found extensive coral bleaching in the Lakshadweep islands. Impact: The death of corals could lead to the collapse of the marine ecosystem in the region. Significance: The survival of the Lakshadweep archipelago is at risk due to the potential collapse of the marine ecosystem.

	 Coral reef bleaching: Coral reef bleaching is a phenomenon where corals lose their vibrant colors and turn white. This occurs when the symbiotic relationship between corals and the algae (zooxanthellae) living within their tissues is disrupted, often due to environmental stress. Causes of Coral Bleaching: Rising Sea Temperatures: The primary cause of coral bleaching is the increase in sea surface temperatures, often linked to global warming. Even a temperature rise of 1-2°C above the normal summer maximum can trigger bleaching. Ocean Acidification: Increased levels of carbon dioxide (CO2) in the atmosphere lead to more CO2 being absorbed by the ocean, causing ocean acidification. This reduces the availability. Pollution: Runoff from agriculture, sewage, and industrial waste introduces harmful substances into the ocean, which can stress coral ecosystems and contribute to bleaching. Overexposure to Sunlight: Excessive sunlight, especially during periods of elevated temperatures, can increase the risk of bleaching by causing thermal stress.
	 Lakshadweep Islands: Lakshadweep is a tropical archipelago comprising 36 atolls and coral reefs situated in the Laccadive Sea, positioned 280 km to 480 km off the Kerala coast. The island is situated in the Laccadive Sea extending between 8 degree N and 12 degree N latitude. The entire Lakshadweep islands group is made up of coral deposits.
