African Union to join G-20 as A Sherpas reach a deal	<ul> <li>African Union</li> <li>The African Union (AU) is a continental body consisting of the 55 member states that make up the countries of the African Continent.</li> <li>It was officially launched in 2002 and replaced its predecessor, the Organization of African Unity (OAU), which was founded in 1963.</li> <li>Primary Objective: To promote unity, cooperation, and development among African nations while advancing the continent's interests on the global stage.</li> <li>It aims to strengthen political, economic, and social integration among African countries, with a vision of achieving an integrated, prosperous, and peaceful Africa.</li> <li>Headquarters: Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.</li> </ul>
Do you know? The G20 works in three major tracks — two of them are official and one is unofficial 1. Sherpa Track 2. Finance Track 3. Engagement groups or civil society groups (Unofficial)	<ul> <li>Finance Track <ul> <li>It is headed by the finance ministers and central bank governors, who usually meet four times a year, with two meetings being held on the sidelines of the World Bank and International Monetary Fund (IMF) meetings.</li> <li>It mainly focuses on fiscal and monetary policy issues such as the global economy, infrastructure, financial regulation, financial inclusion, international financial architecture, and international taxation.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Sherpa Track <ul> <li>It was established after the forum became a leaders' summit in 2008.</li> <li>It consists of representatives of heads of state, and it focuses on socio-economic issues such as agriculture, anti-corruption, climate, digital economy, education, employment, energy, environment, health, tourism, trade, and investment.</li> </ul> </li> <li>The unofficial track comprises engagement or civil groups.</li> </ul>

Clear illegal constructions in ESZ, buffer zone of Bandipur Mrstinkstansata Wanathsata W	<ul> <li>What are eco-sensitive zones (ESZ)?</li> <li>An area around a protected area like a national park or wildlife sanctuary</li> <li>To conserve the biodiversity and ecosystems of protected areas by regulating human activities</li> <li>The government can regulate and restrict certain activities in ESZs through guidelines and laws</li> <li>Bandipur Tiger Reserve <ul> <li>It was established in the 1930s as a wildlife sanctuary, which became a tiger reserve in 1973 under Project tiger.</li> <li>It is situated in Karnataka and located at the tri-junction area of the States of Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and Kerala.</li> <li>This area has the River Kabini in its north and River Moyar in its south.</li> <li>It comprises diverse vegetation of dry deciduous to tropical mixed deciduous. It includes rosewood, Indian kino tree, sandalwood, Indian laurel, clumping bamboo and giant clumping bamboo etc.</li> <li>It is a shelter for the largest population of wild Asian elephants in South Asia. It comprises other mammals such as Bengal tiger, gaur, sloth bear, golden jackal, dhole and four-horned antelope etc.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Water Hyacinth         Image: Additional system of the sy	<ul> <li>Key points: <ul> <li>Water hyacinth (Pontederia crassipes) is an invasive species native to South Africa.</li> <li>The plant has naturalised itself in many other parts of the world.</li> <li>Water hyacinth acts as a water purifier by removing heavy metals from water when present in small quantities.</li> <li>However, the plant is a prolific spreader and when it covers the entire surface of a water body, it does not allow sunlight to penetrate the water and also starts depleting oxygen.</li> <li>This leads to death of aquatic animals and plants, which in turn decompose and further reduce oxygen levels</li> <li>The presence of water hyacinth indicates that there are high nitrogen levels in the water.</li> <li>It is a symptom of an underlying problem and how the water nutrients behave.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

reported from Idukki Dam	<ul> <li>The Idukki Dam is a double curvature Arch dam constructed across the <b>Periyar River</b> in a narrow gorge between two granite hills located in Idukki District in Kerala.</li> <li>At 168.91 metres it is one of the highest arch dams in Asia.</li> <li>This dam was constructed along with two other dams at Cheruthoni and Kulamavu.</li> <li>Together, the three dams and Two saddle dams, Kulamavu Saddle Dam (Near Junction) and Kulamavu Saddle Dam (Right Bank) have created an artificial lake in the area.</li> </ul>
