#### DRI saves 955 Turtles



#### In News:

The Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) seized 955 live turtles of various species living in the Ganges River in Nagpur, Bhopal and Chennai.

#### Key Points:

- The Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) has busted a gang involved in smuggling and selling rare turtle hatchlings found in the Ganges River

#### About turtle

- There are five species of turtles in India
- Green turtle, Hawksbill, loggerhead, leatherback and olive Ridley.
- Related species of turtles have been listed as endangered or vulnerable in Red List of IUCN
- They are protected under the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972
- The operation was done under the 'Operation Kachhap'.


Maharashtra beat Karnataka to win 5th National Wheelchair Rugby Championship 2023.

#### Key facts

- Maharashtra beat Karnataka with the final score of 31-10 in the finals at the recently concluded 5th National Wheelchair Rugby Championship 2023 held at Balewadi, Pune
- The championship was conducted by The Indian Rugby Football Union (Rugby India),
- It is the sole governing body for the sport of rugby in India, in association with the Wheelchair Rugby Federation of India and Mitsubishi Corporation.
- 14 States participated in the event.
- It was the largest national wheelchair event that Rugby India has hosted till date.

<p><b>Inadequate record on E Blood Cell, MH</b></p>	<p><b>In News:</b> Blood collection in Maharashtra seems to be insufficient despite the highest blood collection in Maharashtra under the Ayushyaman Bhava service.</p> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• State Blood Transfusion Council has issued instructions to all the District Blood Transfusion Officers of the state to register on the e-Raktkosh website.</li> <li>• The MahaSBTC website shows that more than 80 thousand units of blood have been collected from blood donation camps</li> <li>• But <b>it is recorded that approximately 30 thousand units of blood have been collected on e-blood cells.</b></li> </ul>
<p><b>E- blood cells</b></p>	<p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• E- blood cells are red blood cells that contain hemoglobin E (HbE).</li> <li>• <b>HbE is a structural variant of hemoglobin</b>, the oxygen-carrying protein in red blood cells</li> <li>• <b>People with E- blood cells may have mild anemia, which is a condition in which the body does not have enough red blood cells to carry oxygen effectively.</b></li> <li>• Anemia can cause symptoms such as fatigue, shortness of breath, and pale skin.</li> </ul>

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
