MoU to be signed to bring tigers from Victoria and Albert Museum in London



Context

Recently the cultural minister of Maharashtra and the Albert museum in London have decided to sign a MoU to bring Vaghanakhe(tiger paws) of Shivaji Maharaj to Maharashtra.

Key facts

- The agreement will be of three years.
- Cultural Affairs Minister Sudhir Mungantiwar left Mumbai to bring Vaghnakhe(tigers paws) of Shivaji Maharaj from Victoria and Albert Museum.
- The MoU will be signed in London on october 7 and then the Vaghanakhe will come to Maharashtra on November 16.
- Vaghanakhe will first be deposited in the architectural Museum of Satara.
- Nagpur, Kolhapur and Mumbai are Other places where it will be deposited at architectural museum
- Then on October 16, 2026, Vaghnakhe will again leave for the Victoria and Albert Museum in London.

3 thousand crores 'booster' to Neera Deoghar

In News

Three thousand crores has recently been approved to expand Neera Deoghar dam.

Key facts

- The investment approval committee of the Union Jal Shakti Ministry has approved the expansion of the 'Neera Deoghar' dam canal.
- Rs 3000 cr has been sanctioned for the expansion work.
- It will be a boon for agriculture as well as drinking water in Pune, Satara, Solapur districts.
- This project will get 'booster' funds from the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Irrigation Yojana.
- An area of about 43 thousand hectares in three districts will come under irrigation due to this expansion.

About Neera Deoghar:

- Neera Deoghar is an earthfill dam on the Niira river near Bhor. Pune district in Maharashtra
- It was constructed in 2000
- It has a total capacity of 332,130 km³ (79,680 cu mi).
- The dam is used for irrigation, drinking water supply, and hydroelectric power generation.
