Mumbai: The City of Seven Islands



Key Points:

- **Mumbai**, formerly known as Bombay, is the capital of the Indian state of Maharashtra and the most populous city in India.
- It is also a major financial and commercial center. Mumbai is located on the western coast of India, on a peninsula that juts out into the **Arabian Sea**.
- The city is known as the "**City of Seven Islands**" because it was built on what was once an archipelago of seven islands.
- These islands were eventually joined together by land reclamation projects.

The seven islands are:

- Isle of Bombay
 - Parel
 - Mazagaon
 - Mahim
 - Worli
 - Old Woman's Island (Little Colaba)
 - Colaba

- In 1947, India gained independence from Britain. Mumbai became the capital of the new state of Bombay.
 - In 1950, the state of **Bombay was split into two states: Maharashtra and Gujarat.**
