	<ul> <li>Key Points: <ul> <li>With 35 new records, PTR is now home to 170 species of butterflies.</li> <li>The survey is conducted twice a year, once during the pre-monsoon season and once during the post-monsoon season.</li> <li>It involves volunteers from all over the country, who help to collect data on a variety of species, including butterflies, birds, mammals, reptiles, and amphibians.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Pench Tiger Reserve:</li> <li>Maharashtra, being the third largest state in India and a leader in protecting biodiversity, bears maximum numbers (six) of tiger reserves in India along with Madhya Pradesh.</li> <li>Pench Tiger Reserve situated in the northern part of eastern Vidarbha is spread in Ramtek, Parseoni and Saoner tehsil of Nagpur district.</li> <li>It is the 25th tiger reserve of India.</li> <li>The Pench Tiger reserve (PTR) which derives its name from its lifeline - the River Pench is spread over 741.41 Sq.km of area.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Key Points:</li> <li>The policy is to be implemented from the current financial year till 2027- '28,</li> <li>It would facilitate investment of Rs 25,000 crore in the state.</li> <li>The policy aims at increasing exports of the state from 72 billion dollars to 150 billion dollars i.e,to increase the state's exports from the current 7% to 14%.</li> </ul>

The government subsidizes the rest of the cost.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
