1. Intrigue (verb)

Meaning; A complicated or clandestine plot



- **Synonyms:** conspire
- **Antonyms:** expose
- **Sentence Example:** The film has **intrigue** storyline.
- **Verb (Definition):** *Verbs* are words that show an action (*sing*), occurrence (*develop*), or state of being (*exist*).

2. Elide (verb)

Meaning; To cut off



- **Synonyms:** separate
- **Antonyms:** join
- **Sentence Example:** The product presentation was not **elided** — it's always only 15 minutes long.
- **Verb (Definition):** *Verbs* are words that show an action (*sing*), occurrence (*develop*), or state of being (*exist*).

3. Forgo (verb)

Meaning; To do without, to abandon, to renounce



- **Synonyms:** Renounce
- **Antonyms:** adopt
- **Sentence Example:** She is planning to *forgo* her right to a trial and simply plead guilty.
- **Verb (Definition):** *Verbs* are words that show an action (*sing*), occurrence (*develop*), or state of being (*exist*).
