1. Damning (adjective)

Meaning; Condemning.



- **Synonyms:** destructive, catastrophic
- **Antonyms:** favourable, optimistic
- **Sentence Example:** Its *damning* October financial report projected optimistically that such an offering would bring in \$139 million in 2024.
- **Adjective (Definition):** *Adjectives* describe or modify—that is, they limit or restrict the meaning of—nouns and pronouns. They may name qualities of all kinds: *huge, red, angry, tremendous, unique, rare*, etc.

2. Cozen (verb)

Meaning; To cheat



- **Synonyms:** deceive, hoax
- **Antonyms:** disclose, unmask
- **Sentence Example:** *Cozened* several elderly ladies into believing that he was intending marriage.

- **Verb (Definition):** *Verbs* are words that show an action (*sing*), occurrence (*develop*), or state of being (*exist*).

3. Discard (verb)

Meaning; to throw away, to reject.



- **Synonyms:** dismiss, dump
- **Antonyms:** retain, store
- **Sentence Example:** They quickly **discarded** the idea.
- **Verb (Definition):** *Verbs* are words that show an action (*sing*), occurrence (*develop*), or state of being (*exist*).
