	About drought crisis:
	 Geographical Impact: The drought crisis in Maharashtra primarily affects the Marathwada, Vidarbha, and parts of Western Maharashtra regions. Causes: Climate Change: Irregular monsoon patterns and reduced rainfall. Water Mismanagement: Inefficient water management practices and over-extraction of groundwater. Agricultural Practices: Dependence on water-intensive crops such as sugarcane.

Maharashtra	 Two new gecko species have been discovered at Kalsubai, Maharashtra's highest peak, and Ratangad fort.
	 Key points: Species Names: The species from Ratangad Fort is named Cnemaspis basalticola or Ratangad dwarf gecko, and the one from Kalsubai is named Cnemaspis kalsubaiensis aka Kalsubai dwarf gecko. Habitat: Both species are found in semi-evergreen forests and on basalt boulders in mountains above 1,100m. Biodiversity Highlighted: The discovery of these endemic geckos highlights the biodiversity of the region.

Kalsubai	Why in the news? • Two new gecko species have been discovered at Kalsubai, Maharashtra's highest peak, and Ratangad fort. About Kalsubai:
	 Location: Kalsubai is located in the Western Ghats of Maharashtra, India, in Ahmednagar district in Akole Taluka. Elevation: It is the highest peak in Maharashtra, with an elevation of 1,646 meters (5,400 feet) above sea level. Significance: Kalsubai is often referred to as the "Everest of Maharashtra". The mountain range lies within the Kalsubai-Harishchandragad Wildlife Sanctuary. The mountain range was formed by the same geological events that gave birth to the Western Ghats.

Maharashtra Chief Minister inaugurated the second phase of Dharmveer Swarajya Rakshak Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj Coastal Road.
