	 Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) are devices used to record votes in an electronic format during elections. Components: Control Unit: Managed by the polling officer, it controls the polling process and stores voting data. Ballot Unit: Used by voters to cast their vote, connected to the control unit via a cable. Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT): Optional component that provides a printed record of the vote cast for verification. Development and Implementation: Introduced: First used in 1982 in Kerala on a trial basis. Full Adoption: Widely adopted in Indian elections since 1999. Manufacturers: Primarily produced by Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL) and Electronics Corporation of India Limited (ECIL).
