#### Why in the news?

- A Chinese vessel and a Philippine supply ship collided near the disputed Spratly Islands in the South China Sea.
- The incident occurred when a Philippine supply ship entered waters near the Second Thomas Shoal, a submerged reef in the **Spratly Islands**, which is claimed by multiple nations.

#### About South China Sea:

- Location: The South China Sea is a marginal sea of the • Western Pacific Ocean, bordered by China, Taiwan, the Philippines, Malaysia, Brunei, Indonesia, Singapore, and Vietnam.
- Trade Routes: It is one of the world's busiest sea lanes, with over one-third of global maritime trade passing through it, including vital oil and gas shipments.
- Territorial Disputes:
  - Claimants: The South China Sea is subject to overlapping territorial claims by China, the Philippines, Vietnam, Malaysia, Brunei, and Taiwan.
  - **Nine-Dash Line**: China's extensive claim marked by the "nine-dash line," which covers most of the South China Sea.
  - Key Areas: Disputed regions include the Spratly Islands, Paracel Islands, Scarborough Shoal, and the Second Thomas Shoal.


