	<ul> <li>About Oath of Member of Parliament in India:</li> <li>Constitutional Provision: The oath for Members of Parliament (MPs) in India is mandated by Article 99 of the Indian Constitution.</li> <li>Oath or Affirmation: MPs can either take an oath or make an</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>affirmation, based on their preference.</li> <li>Administering Authority: The President of India, or a person appointed by the President, administers the oath to the MPs.</li> <li>Language: The oath can be taken in any of the 22 scheduled languages of India as per the Eighth Schedule of the Constitution.</li> <li>Legal Requirement: Taking the oath is a legal requirement before an MP can take their seat in Parliament and participate in any proceedings.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Non-Compliance: If an MP does not take the oath, they are not entitled to sit or vote in the Parliament.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Key points:</li> <li>Location: The center is situated at the Forest Produce Warehouse in Mhasrul Shivara.</li> <li>Significance: The first wildlife treatment center in North Maharashtra.</li> </ul>
