### Zika virus Why

### Why in the news?

- The Centre has issued an advisory to all states, including Maharashtra, to maintain vigilance due to the spread of the Zika virus.
- As of July 2, Maharashtra has reported eight cases of Zika.

### About Zika virus:

- Origin and Spread:
  - First identified in **1947** in **Uganda's Zika Forest**.
  - Primarily spread by **Aedes mosquitoes** (Aedes aegypti and Aedes albopictus).

### • Transmission:

- Mosquito bites.
- o Mother to fetus during pregnancy.
- Sexual contact.
- Blood transfusions (though rare).

### Symptoms:

- Mild fever.
- o Rash.
- o Joint pain.
- Conjunctivitis (red eyes).
- Muscle pain and headache.
- Symptoms typically last for 2-7 days.

### • Complications:

- Microcephaly: Birth defect where a baby's head is smaller than expected.
- Guillain-Barré Syndrome: A rare neurological disorder causing muscle weakness and sometimes paralysis.

	Financial Assistance: Farmers will receive Rs 7 lakh over three years for
	plantation and maintenance.

# Maharashtra Right to Public Services Act, 2015

### Why in the news?

- Maharashtra govt to enhance Right to Services mechanism for timely delivery of 662 government services ahead of Assembly polls.
- Pilot project in Kolhapur to be launched.

### About act:

- The Maharashtra Right to Public Services Act, 2015 ensures that notified services are provided to citizens in a transparent, speedy, and time-bound manner by various government departments and public authorities within the state.
- It applies to the entire state of Maharashtra.
- Eligible Persons:
  - The act defines an "eligible person" as someone who is entitled to obtain a public service.
  - This includes both individuals and legal entities.

### Services Covered:

- The act covers various services provided by state government departments and public authorities.
- These services must be delivered transparently, efficiently, and within stipulated time limits.

### Appellate Authorities:

- The act establishes Appellate Authorities to address grievances related to service delivery.
- **Citizens can appeal** if services are not provided within the specified time frame.

### • Maharashtra State Commission for Right to Service:

- The commission oversees the effective implementation of the act.
- It ensures that eligible persons receive services promptly and transparently.
