• The Indian Coast Guard recently carried out a successful rescue operation off the Alibag coast in Maharashtra.

About Indian Coast Guard:

- Establishment: The Indian Coast Guard (ICG) was formally established on 1 February 1977 by the Coast Guard Act, 1978.
- Motto: "Vayam Rakshamah" (We Protect).
- Role and Responsibilities:
 - Maritime Safety and Security: Ensuring the safety and security of India's maritime zones.
 - Search and Rescue: Conducting search and rescue operations in India's maritime zones.
 - Marine Environment Protection: Preventing and responding to marine pollution.
 - Law Enforcement: Enforcing maritime laws and regulations, including anti-smuggling and anti-piracy operations.
 - Aid to Mariners: Providing navigational aid and assistance to mariners in distress.
 - Defence Operations: Assisting the Indian Navy in defence operations during hostilities.
- Organizational Structure:
 - Headquarters: New Delhi.
 - Regions: The ICG is divided into five regions: North-West, West, East, North-East, and Andaman & Nicobar.
 - Bases: Numerous stations, air stations, and air enclaves along the Indian coastline.
- Collaborations: The ICG collaborates with various national and international agencies for maritime safety, security, and environmental protection, including the Indian Navy, Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Shipping, and International Maritime Organization (IMO).
- Operations:
 - SAR Operations: Regularly conducts search and rescue operations for distressed vessels and people at sea.
