About Bhimashankar Wildlife Sanctuary:

- Location: Situated in the Pune district of Maharashtra.
- Establishment: Declared a wildlife sanctuary in 1984.
- Flora:
 - Rich in diverse plant species, including semi-evergreen and evergreen forests.
 - Contains sacred groves known as "Devrais" which are preserved by local communities.
- Fauna:
 - Home to the state animal of Maharashtra, the giant flying squirrel (Ratufa indica elphinstoni).
 - Other notable species include the Indian pangolin, leopards, sambar deer, barking deer, and various species of birds, reptiles, and insects.
- Avifauna: Significant species include the Malabar whistling thrush, green pigeon, and guaker babbler.
- Geography: Part of the Western Ghats, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

About Humboldt penguins:

- Scientific Name: Spheniscus humboldti
- Habitat:
 - Native to the coasts of Peru and Chile in South America.
 - Prefer rocky coastal regions and islands.
