 India's first ready-to-drink fig juice, made from GI-tagged Purandar figs, was recently exported to Poland with the facilitation of the Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA).

About Purandar Figs:

- Known as one of India's finest figs, renowned for their sweet taste, size, and nutritional benefits.
- Cultivated in various villages of Purandar taluk,
 Pune district, Maharashtra.
- Agro-Climatic Factors:
 - Requires dry weather, hilly slopes, and well-drained medium land for cultivation.
 - Purandar has red and black soil rich in Calcium and Potassium, contributing to the fig's violet color and size.
- GI Tag: Awarded the Geographical Indication (GI) Tag in 2016.
- Features:
 - Bell-shaped and larger in size compared to other fig varieties.
 - Distinctive violet skin color.
 - Rich source of vitamins and minerals.

Why in the news?

 The Maharashtra government has announced that the Chief Minister's Office will manage the CM Vayoshree Scheme, a dedicated assistance program for senior citizens.

Key points:

- The scheme will now be administered through district collectors and municipal commissioners.
- The CM Vayoshree Scheme provides a one-time payment of Rs 3,000 to senior citizens, which will be deposited directly into their Aadhaar-linked bank accounts.
- Previously, Central Public Sector Undertakings (CPSUs) were responsible for beneficiary selection, document verification, and collecting Aadhaar and bank account data.

- Key Features:
 - o Free Electricity: Households can receive up to 300 units of electricity per month at no cost.
 - Subsidy: The subsidy amount varies based on the capacity of the solar plant installed.
 - o Eligibility: Indian citizens owning a house with a suitable roof and a valid electricity connection can apply.
