Please note that

- (1) both the GATE score criteria and the criteria for % marks/CGPA needs to be satisfied for admission to M.Tech. and MS(R) programs.
- (2) the creamy layer among the OBCs have been excluded from the benefit of reservation. Each candidate seeking admission would be required to submit the OBC (Non-creamy layer) certificate as per the prescribed template. Further, (s)he should also give a declaration/undertaking in the prescribed format. - (3) If you think you qualify for the interview based on the above criteria but have not received a call letter, please appear for the interview as per the details below.

Information for candidates shortlisted for interview

1. A list of shortlisted candidates is available at the website of the Department of Chemical Engineering (<http://chemical.iitd.ac.in/prospective-students/>). No separate interview call letter will be sent by post.

2. All the shortlisted candidates should report to the Dept. of Chem. Engg. (Block II, Room 278) at **08:30 AM** on **16.05.2019 (THURSDAY)**. Candidates should make their travel plan such that they might have to stay till late evening.
3. No TA is admissible to the candidates appearing for test/interview for admission to M.Tech./ M.S.(Research) programmes.
4. Fee once paid for a particular programme will not be adjusted/ transferred if the student gets selected subsequently and joins in another programme. He/She will have to pay the fee for the new programme he/she joins and apply for refund of fee earlier paid for a programme he/she wishes to withdraw. The refund of fee will be made as per rules of the Institute.
5. Hostel accommodation for candidates coming for interviews is arranged at ZANSKAR hostel (caretaker number: 011 2659 7068) for male candidates and at HIMADRI hostel (caretaker number: 011 2659 7135) for the female candidates. The hostel accommodation will be provided on a sharing basis on payment of Rs. 400 per day (lodging & boarding). The bedding is not provided and candidates will have to make their own arrangement for bedding. However, the Caretaker of concerned hostel will help to arrange bedding @ 50/- (per set) per day. The Payment shall be made by way of **Demand Draft** drawn in favour of “**Deans Discretionary Fund, IIT Delhi.....(hostel name) Hostel**”.
