

KPSC Motor Vehicle Inspector Exam Pattern 2024

It is strongly recommended that all candidates obtain precise and pertinent details concerning the KPSC Motor Vehicle Inspector Exam Pattern 2024, as this pattern holds significant importance for applicants in preparing for the upcoming examination.

Kannada Language Test: No candidate shall be eligible for selection unless he has qualified in the Kannada Language Test as specified in sub-rule (7) of the Karnataka Civil Service (Direct Recruitment) (General) Rules 2021 for the said posts. This examination consists of one question paper of a maximum of 150 marks and a candidate must score at least 50 marks on this paper to qualify. The question paper will be prepared with Kannada as the first language at the SSLC level as the standard.

After qualifying in the Kannada language test for the said posts, it is mandatory to secure at least 35% marks in the competitive test conducted as per sub-rule 5(d) of the Karnataka Civil Service (Direct Recruitment) (General) Rules, 2021. Selection will be made based on the percentage of marks secured in this examination (Based on the percentage of marks secured in the Competitive Examination) and according to the prevailing reservation rules.

Competitive exam question papers will be in Kannada and English language only. If there is any ambiguity in the translation of the questions in the Kannada language in the question paper, the candidates should refer to the English language questions and understand them. The schedule of the Kannada Language Test/ Competitive Examinations for the said posts will be published later on the website of the Commission.

The Karnataka Civil Services (Direct Recruitment) (Samana) Rules, 2021 provides that the competitive examination conducted for posts requiring a Diploma or any other qualification below the degree level shall consist of two papers. Each paper consists of written questions of a maximum of 100 marks and is of objective multiple choice type. Each question in these two papers is of negative marking format and for each wrong answer one-fourth (1/4) of the marks allotted to the question will be deducted, the candidates must appear for both papers.
