TERMS AND CONDITIONS:-

1. The Contract engagement will be purely on contract basis up to the end of current academic session 2023-2024 or till the joining of regular incumbent, whichever is earlier.
2. The contract engagement will automatically stand terminated on expiry of the stipulated contract period or till a regular appointee posted against the particular vacancy joins duty, whichever is earlier.
3. The contract will be purely on contract basis and the contract teachers/ personnel will not have any claim for extension of the Agreement or regularization of service in future.
4. The contract teacher will employ herself/himself efficiently and diligently and will devote his/her whole time to the duties of the service and will not engage directly or indirectly in any trade, business or occupation on his/her own account.
5. At the termination of the Contract, the Contract Teacher will not entitled for any terminal benefits from the Principal or the Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti.
6. Notwithstanding anything in the Contract, the Principal may terminate the services of the Contract Teacher before the expiry of the contract period or in case:-
 - {a} His/her work is found unsatisfactory.
 - {b} If his/her conduct is found to be unbecoming of a Govt. Servant and unsuitable for a Co-educational residential Institution.
7. The Contract personnel have to stay in the Vidyalaya campus. The contract teacher will be entitled for rent free bachelor accommodation within the Vidyalaya campus, if and as available, and is entitled for free meals along with the students.
8. The Contract Teacher will have to perform duties in Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya at par with the regular teaching staff and as per the directions given by Principal.

9. In case the regular incumbent joins during contract period, one month remuneration will not be paid to the contractual staff.
11. Candidates should report at the place of allotment with original certificates, mark sheets and with a set of self-attested Photostat copies of the same, experience certificate and one recent passport size photograph and identifications proof like Voter ID, Aadhaar Card or identity card issued by Govt. Schools.
12. The candidates offered contract appointment will have to execute a Contract Agreement on Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred only) Non-Judicial Stamp in the prescribed format of contract agreement before the Principal of the respective JNV.
