The present petition has been instituted by the petitioner seeking invalidation of a notification dated 28.06.2018 issued by the National Council for Teacher Education (hereinafter "the NCTE") in terms of direction of the Central Government given under Section 23(1) of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009. This notification introduced certain amendments to an earlier dated 23rd August 2010 laying down necessary qualification for teachers, both at the primary as also the upper primary level. Substance of the amendment notification was that the candidates holding B.Ed. degree would be entitled to be appointed as primary school teachers subject to fulfilling certain other requirements.

But this Court expects that the State of Bihar shall take into account the judgment of this Court delivered on 11.08.2023.
