## 1. EXAMINATION FEES AND MODE OF PAYMENT:-

- i. A Non-Refundable Fee of ₹ 150 for APST candidates and ₹ 200 for GENERAL candidates (to be paid online only).
- ii. Persons with Disabilities (PwD) are exempt from paying the fees.

#### 2. ELIGIBILTY CRITERIA: -

- i. The candidate must be a citizen of India.
- ii. The educational qualification, age, experience as stipulated in the advertisement shall be determined as on the closing date of submission of application.

### 3. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:-

The examination will be of 3 (three) stages for Post codes 4/23, 5/23 and 6/23. For post codes 7/23, 8/23 and 9/23 the examination shall be of 1(one) stage only.

## Stage-I: Physical Standard Test (PST) and Physical Efficiency Test (PET)

- i. The candidates for post codes 4/23 (Constable (AAPBn/Civil Police/IRBn)), 5/23 (Constable) and 6/23 (Fireman) will have to qualify PST and PET as mentioned against each post code at pages 4 and 5 of this advertisement.
- ii. The Ex-servicemen candidates are exempted from appearing the Physical Efficiency Test (PET). However, they will have to appear and qualify the Physical Standard Test (PST).

## Stage- II: (Objective Type Multiple Choice Questions) - 300 Marks

The test will comprise of the following subjects:-

## (a) General English - 100 marks (50 questions of 2 marks each):-

<u>Syllabus</u>:-In addition to testing of candidate's understanding and comprehension of the English language, questions on its vocabulary, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms and its correct usage etc would also be covered.

## (b) Elementary Math - 100 marks (50 questions of 2 marks each):-

<u>Syllabus</u>:-The test of Arithmetical and Numerical abilities will cover number systems including questions on Simplification, Decimals, Data Interpretations, Fractions, LCM, HCF, Ratio and Proportion, Percentage, Average, Profit and Loss, Discount, Simple and Compound Interest, Mensuration, Time and Work, Time and Distance, Tables and Graphs etc.

## (c) General Knowledge - 100 marks (50 questions of 2 marks each):-



- <u>Syllabus</u>: Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidates General Knowledge of the environment around him/her and its application to society. The questions will be designed to test knowledge of Current Events and of such matter of everyday observation as may be expected of an educated person. The Test will also include questions relating to History, Polity, Constitution, Sports, Art and Culture, Geography, Economics, Everyday Science, Scientific Research, National/International Organizations/Institutions etc. State specific questions may also be asked.
- > The test will be of Objective Type Multiple Choice Questions comprising of 150 questions as mentioned above. Each question will carry 2 (two) marks. The candidate will have to complete the test in 03 (three) hours.
- ➤ A candidate must secure a minimum of 33% in each subject in the written examination paper. The candidate securing less than 33% of marks in any of the subject shall be deemed not eligible for selection. <a href="https://doi.org/10.2016/journal.org/">There is no negative marking</a>.

#### Stage- III: Medical Fitness Test

i. The candidates for post codes 4/23 (Constable (AAPBn/Civil Police/IRBn)), 5/23 (Constable) and 6/23 (Fireman) will have to qualify the medical fitness test as mentioned against each post code at pages 4 and 5 of this advertisement.

- Stage I (PST/PET) and Stage III (Medical Fitness Test) shall be of Qualifying nature only.
