**Arunachal Pradesh PSC Prelims Syllabus-** Here is the syllabus for the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (APPSC) Preliminary Examination:

<b>Paper</b>	<b>Important Topics</b>
Paper 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Current events of national and international importance.</li><li>b. History of India and Indian national movement.</li><li>c. Indian and World Geography-physical, social, and economic geography of India and the world.</li><li>d. Indian Polity and governance – Constitution, Political System, Panchayati Raj, Public Policy, Rights Issues, etc.</li><li>e. Economic and Social Development – Sustainable Development, Poverty, Inclusion, Demographics, Social Sector Initiatives, etc.</li><li>f. Environmental Ecology, Bio-diversity, and Climate Change – that do not require subject specialization.</li><li>g. General Science</li></ul>
General Studies Paper-II	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Comprehension</li><li>b. Interpersonal skills including communication skills</li><li>c. Logical reasoning and analytical ability</li><li>d. Decision-making and problem-solving</li><li>e. General mental ability</li><li>f. Basic numeracy (numbers and their relations, orders of magnitude, etc.) (Class X level)</li><li>g. Data interpretation (charts, graphs, tables, data sufficiency, etc. - Class X level)</li></ul>

## Arunachal Pradesh PSC Syllabus – Mains

The main Examination of the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (APPSC) consists of five compulsory papers and three optional papers. The compulsory papers cover General English, Essay Writing, General Studies Paper-I, General Studies Paper-II, and an Indian Language paper.

<b>Paper</b>	<b>Syllabus</b>
English Qualifying Paper	Comprehension, Precise Writing, Short Essays, Usage, and Vocabulary
Essay	Topics from current affairs, international matters, and editorials. Candidates are evaluated on the correct usage of functional Grammar, vocabulary, and presentation.
Mains General Studies-1	Indian Heritage and Culture, History and Geography of the World and Society

<b>Paper</b>	<b>Syllabus</b>
Mains General Studies-2	Polity, Social Justice, International Relations, Constitution, Governance
Mains General Studies-3	Technology, Biodiversity, Environment, Security, Disaster Management, Development
Mains General Studies-4	Ethics, Aptitude, Integrity
Optional Papers-1 and 2	Chemistry, Mathematics, Commerce and Accountancy, Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Science, Civil Engineering, Botany, Medical Science, Anthropology, Electrical Engineering, Geography, Geology, History, Zoology, Law, Philosophy, Management, Mechanical engineering, Physics, Political Science and International Relations, Sociology, Statistics, Psychology

## **Arunachal Pradesh PSC Prelims Exam Pattern 2023**

The Arunachal Pradesh PSC Prelims Exam consists of two papers: Paper 1 and Paper 2. Both papers are conducted on the same day.

- The Arunachal Pradesh PSC Prelims exam has two papers.
- The medium of the exam is English.
- Each paper has a duration of two hours.
- Both papers are compulsory for selection.
- The type of questions in multiple-choice questions (MCQs).
- The total marks for both papers combined are 400.
- Paper 2 is of qualifying nature.
- The minimum passing percentage for Paper 2 is 33%.

## **Arunachal Pradesh PSC Mains Exam Pattern 2023**

- The Arunachal Pradesh PSC Mains exam is the second stage of the recruitment process.
- The exam consists of a written test, which is divided into two parts: Part A-Paper 1 and Part B-7 Papers.
- The mode of examination is offline.
- The type of questions in the exam is descriptive, and the duration of the exam is 3 hours.
- The total marks for the exam are 2050 marks.
