Mizoram PSC Mains Syllabus

The Mizoram MPSC Mains Syllabus is the second stage of the Mizoram Public Service Commission exam. The exam consists of six papers, and candidates need to clear each paper to be eligible for the interview round. The six papers include General English, Essay Writing in English, General Studies Paper I, General Studies Paper II, Optional Subject Paper I, and Optional Subject Paper II. The optional subject papers are chosen by the candidate from a list of subjects provided by the commission.

General Comprehension of given passages, Précis Writing, Usage and Vocabulary, Letter English writing

General Essay Candidates will have to write an essay on the given topic. The essay will be judged on clarity of thought, and basic knowledge of the subject. Credit will be given for effective and exact expression.

General Studies I: Indian Art, History, and Literature and Mizo language. Indian History of 17 and 18 centuries, Salient features of Indian Society, Diversity of India. Role of women and women's organization, globalization, Social empowerment, Communalism, Regionalism & Secularism.

General Indian Constitution historical underpinnings, evolution, features, functions and Studies responsibilities of the Union and the States, Comparison of the Indian constitutional II: scheme with that of other countries. India and its neighborhood relations

General Indian Economy and issues relating to planning, mobilization of resources, Growth, Studies Development and Employment, government budgeting, major crops, land reforms

III: in India, Infrastructure, Energy, Ports, Roads, Airports, Railways, etc.

General Ethics and Human Interface, Essence, determinants and consequences of Ethics in Studies human actions; dimensions of ethics; ethics in private and public relationships,

Paper 1 is the General Studies paper, which consists of multiple-choice questions (MCQs) covering a wide range of subjects such as Indian polity, economy, history, geography, current affairs, science, and technology.
