Siliguri youth Janmejoy Sarkar shines in launch of Aditya L1, the first solar mission of India

Key Points:

- Janmejoy, who has been working at the Inter-University Centre for Astronomy and Astrophysics (IUCAA) in Pune, has been a part of the team of scientists that worked on the integration, calibration and testing of the functioning of the solar ultraviolet imaging telescope (SUIT) of the satellite.
- Aditya L1 is a solar mission by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO). It is designed to study the Sun's atmosphere and its impact on the Earth's atmosphere.

- It was once widespread in South Bengal.
- Now it has become endangered.
- Prefers to stay in open green grasslands and marshes
- It is associated with Bengali rituals and emotions.
- Also popularly known as "Neelkanth".

In the last 12 years, the number of blue herons has decreased by about 30 percent. Not only Nilakantha, various birds like Madantak, Chakhachkhi, Puli Shalik, Dhanesh are gradually decreasing in this state.

Bengal's four birds have been identified as critically endangered:

- 1. 'Yellow Breasted Bunting',
- 2. 'Rufous Necked Hornbill',
- 3. 'Brown Winged Kingfisher',
- 4. 'Great Parrotbill'
