Key points The entire money will be utilised for the purpose of infrastructure development in a state. Focus would be improvement of road networks and water transport systems in the state. It will be utilised for special training of the people engaged in the logistic sector. A target for setting up four economic corridors covering an area of 930 km. Out of that, the longest corridor of 630 km will be in North Bengal and the remaining three will be in South Bengal.



Key points This is done as a measure to control rising pollution levels in the state because of automobile fuel emission, The vehicles taken on rent by the administration will also be electric vehicles only, as per a notification issued by the state Transport Department As per the notification, in case of emergencies, the administration will also be able to hire petrol-driven or diesel-driven vehicles. But a prior permission of the state Finance Department will be necessary for that.
