Atmospheric water generator unveiled in Darjeeling	<ul> <li>Context <ul> <li>Atmospheric water generator unveiled at Ghoom</li> <li>Girls' Higher Secondary School in Darjeeling.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Key points <ul> <li>An atmospheric water generator (AWG)</li> <li>condenses water vapor present in the air to provide pure drinking water.</li> <li>It was introduced by CSIR-Indian Institute of Chemical Technology (CSIR-IICT) and Maithri Aquatech.</li> <li>The plant uses state-of-the-art technology to generate potable water which is enriched with a proprietary mineral solution and passed through an intricate filtration process to ensure potable water standards.</li> <li>It has a capacity to produce 500 liters of water per day.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Relocation for Rhinos	<ul> <li>Context <ul> <li>Five new habitats have been identified in north Bengal for relocation of rhinos from Jaldapara and Gorumara national parks.</li> <li>This was due to overpopulation of the animal in the NPs.</li> </ul> </li> <li>About One Horned Rhinos <ul> <li>The greater one-horned rhino (or "Indian rhino") is the largest of the rhino species.</li> <li>It is identified by a single black horn and a gray-brown hide with skin folds.</li> <li>It is one of the five species of Rhinos.</li> <li>They are grazers.</li> <li>This species of rhino is commonly found in Nepal, Bhutan, Pakistan and in Assam, India.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Gorumara National Park	<ul> <li>About Gorumara National Park <ul> <li>It is located in the Dooars region of the Himalayan foothills in the state of West Bengal.</li> <li>Park was established in 1992.</li> <li>It is primarily known for its population of Indian rhinoceros.</li> <li>This region has rolling forests and riverine grasslands and tropical orchids.</li> <li>The park is located on the floodplains of the Murti River and Raidak River and Jaldhaka river, of the Brahmaputra river system.</li> <li>The park is 79.99 km in area.</li> <li>The park is on the flyway of numerous migratory birds , including the rare Brahminy Duck .</li> <li>The Fauna of The Park includes Indian Rhinoceros , Gaur , Asian Elephant, Sloth bear, Chital , and Sambar Deer . Small herbivores include Barking deer , Hog deer and Wild boar.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
