Sundarbans	 About Sundarban It spread over India and Bangladesh on the delta (the world's largest) of the Ganges, Brahmaputra and Meghna rivers. It contains the world's largest mangrove forests. It is the only mangrove forest in the world inhabited by tigers. Sundarbans Tiger Reserve was created in 1973. Sundarbans National Park, established in 1984, constitutes a core region within the tiger reserve. It was designated a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1987. Sunderbans was designated as a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO in 2001. Sundarban Wetland, India was recognised as the 'Wetland of International Importance' under the Ramsar Convention in January 2019. 		
Fresh spells of rainfall have aggravated dengue menace, say health experts	Context The fresh spells of rainfall that hit several North and South West Bengal districts have aggravated dengue menace in the city Dengue It is caused by the dengue virus (DENV). It is transmitted to humans through the Aedes aegypti mosquito. It is more common in tropical and subtropical climates. Symptoms: The most common symptoms are high fever, headache, body aches, nausea and rash.
