Sabuj Sathi scheme



Key facts:

 Scheme for distribution of bicycles to an estimated 40 lakh students studying in classes IX to XII in Government and Government Aided Schools and Madrasahs of the State

Objective

The scheme was conceived with the primary objective of enhancing student access to Secondary Education. The scheme is further expected-

- To increase retention in schools,
- To encourage students to take up higher studies,
- To inculcate a sense of confidence among the girl students by promoting mobility,
- To promote environment-friendly and healthy means of transportation.

Senchal and Mahananda Wildlife Sanctuary

Mahananda Wildlife Sanctuary

- It is located on the foothills of the Himalayas in the Darjeeling district, between the Teesta and Mahananda Rivers (a small tributary of the Ganga).
- Supports a large number of species of mammals, birds, and reptiles, including Indian bison, royal Bengal tiger, leopard, elephant, sambar, barking deer, wild boar, Himalayan tahr, and Himalayan black bear
- Also home to some endangered species, such as the fairy bluebird and the Himalayan pied hornbill

Senchal Wildlife Sanctuary:

- Located in the Darjeeling district; contiguous with the Singalila National Park.
- Established in 1915, one of the oldest wildlife sanctuaries in India
- Provides habitat for a variety of wildlife, including barking deer, wild boar, Himalayan black bear, Indian leopard, jungle cat, rhesus monkey, Assam macaque, and Himalayan flying squirrel.

Gajoldoba to get new viewpoints

Context:

The Bengal Tourism Department, along with state government agencies, is developing viewpoints at different locations in Gajoldoba of Jalpaiguri district so that tourists can see Mount Kanchenjunga and various species of migratory birds that winter in the area.

Key Points:

- The viewpoints are coming up at **Bhorer Alo**, the mega tourism hub that the government set up near the Teesta barrage.
- Gajoldoba is known for migratory birds. Besides, Mt Kanchenjungha is sighted from here.
- At Gajoldoba, the chief minister had marked a site that comprises the Teesta River and some adjoining water bodies as a bird sanctuary. She named the sanctuary as Pakhibitan.
- At least 150 species of migratory and local birds have been sighted at Gajoldoba.

Rupashree Prakalpa Scheme





- The Rupashree Prakalpa Scheme is a social welfare scheme launched by the Government of West Bengal, India, in 2018.
- The scheme aims to provide one-time financial assistance to economically disadvantaged families of the state for the marriage of their daughters.
- The scheme is an important initiative that aims to provide financial assistance to girls' families who are economically weaker so that they can celebrate their daughter's marriage with dignity and without financial burden.
- The scheme applies to the girl child of a family residing in West Bengal.
- The family's annual income should be less than or equal to Rs. 1.5 lakhs.
- Under the scheme, eligible families receive a one-time financial assistance of Rs. 25,000 for the marriage of their daughters.
- The amount is directly transferred to the bank account of the girl's parents or guardians.
