Yuvasree Scheme	<ul> <li>It is a financial assistance scheme of the Government of West Bengal for the unemployed youth of West Bengal.</li> <li>This scheme was previously known as YuvaUtsahaPrakolpo (YUP).</li> <li>This scheme was implemented in October 2013 and is maintained by the Labour Department of West Bengal.</li> <li>The motto of Yuvasree is to provide employment assistance to the unemployed youths of West Bengal to increase their employment ability and skills.</li> </ul>
NijoGrihaNijo Bhumi Prakalpo Scheme	<ul> <li>It was launched on 18th October 2011 to provide 5 decimal of land to each identified eligible beneficiary family i.e. to all landless homesteadless agricultural labourers, village artisans, and fishermen in rural areas.</li> <li>Aims To provide Secured ownership of a small piece of land</li> <li>Pattas are distributed either in the name of a woman who is the head of the family or jointly both in the name of the wife &amp; husband.</li> <li>Priorities are also given to the eligible beneficiaries of the weakest section of society.</li> <li>All the benefitted families receive pattas, record-of-rights and possession of the land on the spot.</li> </ul>
