The fruit processing and horticulture department of the state government has sanctioned a sum of Rs 68 lakh for the project to be set up across 5 acres of land.
Rhododendrons Image: State of the state of t	 They are a diverse genus of about 1,000 species of woody flowering plants in the heath family (Ericaceae), notable for their attractive flowers and handsome foliage. Distribution: They are native to the temperate regions of Asia, North America, and Europe, as well as to the tropical regions of southeast Asia and northern Australia. Habitat: They occur in a variety of habitats, including alpine regions, coniferous and broadleaved woodlands, temperate rain forests, and even tropical jungle They also require slightly acidic soil to grow well. They exhibit an enormous diversity of size and shape, from prostrate ground covers growing no more than a few inches high to trees more than 100 feet tall. There are 132 taxa (80 species, 25 subspecies, and 27 varieties) of rhododendrons found in India. Rhododendron, also known as "Lali Guras" in a local language, is the national flower of Nepal and the state tree of the state of Uttarakhand in India.
Mahananda Wildlife Sanctuary plans to hold a bird festival	 Context The recent visit of former Team India cricketer Anil Kumble, also an avid birdwatcher and a keen wildlife photographer, to Darjeeling hills has given the forest department the impetus to resume the annual bird festival at the Mahananda Wildlife Sanctuary. About WLS Located in the Darjeeling district of West Bengal established as a wildlife sanctuary in 1976. This is situated between the Mahananda and Teesta rivers in the Terai plains of Darjeeling.

	 Nine major forest ranges, i.e. Kalijhora, Latpanchork, Punding, Sukuna, Gulma, Toribari, Sevoke, Seventh Mile and latlong. The Terai belt of the sanctuary is an important corridor for elephants migrating from Nepal through West Bengal to Assam. Fauna: Bengal Tiger, elephants, bison, spotted deer, rare mountain goats, porcupines, hornbills, swallows, swift, sunbird, etc. are found here.
Sundarbans	 Sundarbans is a vast contiguous mangrove forest ecosystem in the coastal region of the Bay of Bengal spread over India and Bangladesh on the delta (world's largest) of the Ganges, Brahmaputra and Meghna rivers. It contains the world's largest mangrove forests. It is the only mangrove forest in the world inhabited by tigers. Sundarbans Tiger Reserve was created in 1973. Sundarbans National Park, established in 1984, constitutes a core region within the tiger reserve. It was designated a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1987. Sunderbans was designated as a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO in 2001. Sundarban Wetland, India was recognized as the 'Wetland of International Importance' under the Ramsar Convention in January 2019.
