Scrub typhus

DANGER OF BEING UNDETECTED

CAUSED BY Bacteria called orientia tsutsugamushi		WHERE DO CHIGGER MITES STAY? ➤ Moist, grassy areas like fields, forests, lawns, lakes and streams
CARRIED BY Mite called Leptotrombidium, also known as chigger		BABY BITES ➤ Adult chiggers do not bite. It's the babies, at the larval stage, that you have to watch out for ➤ They're red, orange, yellow, or straw-coloured, no more than 0.3mm in length
SYMPTOMS Fever, muscle pain, cough, gastrointestinal symptoms, liver and spleen enlargement, and meningitis in extreme cases		
TREATMENT Doxycyclin, fluids, supportive measures		

Context

The total number of scrub typhus cases in Jalpaiguri district has risen

About

- It is caused by a zoonotic rickettsial bacterium called **Orientia tsutsugamushi**, which is transmitted to humans through the **bites of infected chiggers (larval mites)**.
- Mites carrying the disease are generally found in the bush, jungle and paddy areas, so the disease is also called **jungle or bush typhus**.
- The symptoms of scrub typhus commonly include fever, headache, body aches and sometimes a rash.

State to start new portal to give medical VISA

Context:

- The Bengal government aims to introduce a new portal for issuing **medical visas within a short turnaround of two days**.
- The initiative is primarily focused on facilitating patients from **Bangladesh and other neighboring countries seeking medical treatment in Bengal**.

Key Points:

- Presently, obtaining a medical visa takes around one to one-and-a-half months.
- The state government aims to make the portal operational by **mid-December**.
- In 2021, over 24 lakh medical tourists came to **India from Bangladesh** for treatment, highlighting the substantial demand for healthcare services in the region.

Tourist Tax in Darjeeling



Context:

- **Darjeeling Municipality** has decided to reintroduce a tourist tax of ₹20 per tourist visiting the hill station.
- The decision comes after a gap of more than a decade, as the tax was **last imposed in 2012**.

Key Points:

- Darjeeling is a popular hill destination in north Bengal, known as the **'Queen of Hills.'**
- It attracts over a million tourists annually, offering stunning views of Mt Khangchendzonga, **the third-highest mountain in the world**.

Citizenship Amendment Act final draft to be ready by March 30, 2024

Context:

Objective: Grant Indian citizenship to Hindus, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains, Parsis, and Christians from Afghanistan, Bangladesh, and Pakistan who entered India before December 31, 2014.

Background:

- West Bengal has a long history of migration from neighboring countries, particularly **Bangladesh**.
- The influx of refugees, especially during the **1971 Bangladesh Liberation War**, created a significant Bengali Muslim population in the state.
- The CAA and NRC were seen as threatening this community's citizenship rights.

UNESCO World Heritage sites in West Bengal

- **Sundarbans National Park**
 - The world's largest estuarine mangrove forest, located on the delta of the Ganges, Brahmaputra, and Meghna rivers. It was declared a **World Heritage Site in 1987**.
- **Santiniketan, West Bengal** has been inscribed on UNESCO's list of World Heritage Sites.
- **Darjeeling Himalayan Railway (1999), Darjeeling, West Bengal.**
- **Bishnupur Temples**
 - The Bishnupur Temples are a group of 18th-century temples built by the Malla rulers of Bishnupur.
 - The temples are known for their intricate terracotta carvings, which depict scenes from Hindu mythology and everyday life.
