Indochinese Roller Bird: A new Distinct species	 Recent Discovery: The Indochinese Roller, previously thought to be a type of Indian Roller, is now recognized as a separate species due to its unique characteristics. Study by BNHS: The Bombay Natural History Society conducted a detailed study on this bird's behavior, focusing on its movements, breeding, conservation, and potential threats in North-East India and the Buxa Tiger Reserve. International Recognition: The study's findings have been published in the journal 'Threatened Taxa,' highlighting the importance of this bird on a global scale. Habitat and Behavior: These birds are not only found in India but also in Southeast Asia, residing in deep forests on tall tree trunks. They are known as 'farmer's friends,' helping control crop-damaging insects during harvest seasons. Name Change: Formerly known as the 'Indian Roller,' they are now called 'Indochinese Roller' to reflect their global presence. Their distinct features, such as an 'unstreaked smoky-purplish brown face and breast,' set them apart from the Indian Roller.
Hottest November ever in 22 years	 Context: Kolkata experienced its hottest November in 22 years, with an average lowest temperature above 21 degrees Celsius. Key Points: In 1883, during a pre-global warming phase, Kolkata recorded its lowest temperature of 10.6 degrees Celsius. In the current century, the lowest November temperature was around 14 degrees Celsius in 2012. Current Scenario: This year, the lowest temperature reached around 19 degrees Celsius, higher than the average expected temperature of 20 degrees Celsius.

It is a global health awareness day dedicated to raising awareness of the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS), as well as honoring those who have lost their lives to the disease. It was initiated in 1988 by WHO The World Health Organization (WHO), alongside communities and partners, will mark World AIDS Day 2023, under the theme "Let communities lead". Significance: Raising Awareness:

Cage culturing of fishes	 Context: The state Fisheries department will soon introduce cage culture of fishes at two water bodies — one in New Town and another at Kumari area in Kangsabati River in Bankura district.
	 Cage Culturing: Cage culture, also known as net-pen culture, is an aquaculture technique that involves raising fish in existing water resources. Fish are kept in floating net pens that allow water to pass freely between the fish and the pond. This allows for water exchange and waste removal.
	 Key Points: In March, the state Directorate of Fisheries partnered with ICAR-Central Inland Fisheries Research Institute, Barrackpore, to promote cage culture. The project aims to increase table fish production, strengthen the Directorate's capacity, and support resource user communities and cooperatives.
	 New Policy to Curb Fish Theft: A new policy titled 'Earn Your Wages' is in the works to tackle fish theft by some Daily Rated Workers (DRWs). 1150 DRWs across 22 districts monitor fishing activities, and the policy aims to use revenue from pond pisciculture to pay them.
