Tulaipanji rice



- It is a non-basmati aromatic rice that got GI status in 2017.
- It is being produced mostly in the **Uttar Dinajpur district**.
- The Mohiniganj area of North Dinajpur is famous for Tulaipanji rice.
- Tulaipanji is one of the better-known folk rice varieties of Bengal,.
- The aromatic rice variety is slender, firm with a good bite and delightfully mellow.
- Apart from its flavoursome characteristics, Tulaipanji is much appreciated for its pest resistance.

Haliday Island Wildlife Sanctuary



- It is Located in the state of West Bengal, the area is approximately six square kilometers in size.
- It is a part of the 'Sundarbans Biosphere Reserve', with the Sundarbans region as a whole becoming a 'Biosphere Reserve' officially in 1989.
- The wildlife-heavy areas there are regarded as an environmentally-minded tourist destination.
- It is Situated on the river Matla.
- Many different types of flora and fauna exist within the wildlife sanctuary. Examples include spotted deer and wild boar. Bengal tigers have occasionally visited the area as well.

Rasikbil



- It is also known as Rasik Bil or Rasikbeel
- It is a small lake situated in the Cooch Behar district of West Bengal, India.
- The nearest town is **Kamakhyaguri**.
- This lake attracts a variety of birds.
- They make nests in the trees around the lake.
- The bird species that live in and around the lake includes cormorants, different varieties of storks, ibis, spoonbill, kingfisher, parrots, owls, and many others

Neora Valley National Park



- It is a national park in Kalimpong district, West Bengal,
- It was established in 1986.
- It spreads over an area of 88 km2 and is a rich biological zone in eastern India.
- It is the land of the red panda in the pristine undisturbed natural habitat with rugged inaccessible hilly terrain and rich diverse flora and fauna.
- It is linked to the Pangolakha Wildlife Sanctuary of Pakyong District as well as the forests of Samtse District, Bhutan via a thick cover of forests

Rupnarayan River

- It is famous for the Hilsa fish that live in it and are used in Bengali cuisine.
- It is also notable for the West Bengal Power Development Corporation Limited (WBPDCL) thermal power plant built along its bank at Kolaghat in West Bengal.
- The river passes through Bagnan in Howrah district.
- Rupnarayan River forms the eastern boundary of district Purba Medinipur with district Howrah.
