Bengal government to introduce waiver scheme for tax defaulters	 The state government is introducing a unique 'Waiver Scheme 2023-24' offering a 100 percent waiver of penalty accrued on taxes due till December 31, 2023, for 60 days from January 1 till February 29, 2024. As per estimates of the Transport Department, there are around 12.5 lakh vehicles that have tax pending, have not done a certificate of fitness (CF) in due time, or have not renewed their permit.
Home Affordability Index	Context • Kolkata has bagged the second spot in the home affordability index among Indian cities with a ratio of 24 percent in 2023. • The ratio level of the city has improved by one percent from 2022 and by eight percent from the pre-pandemic year of 2019, according to Knight Frank India's proprietary 'Affordability Index'.
18th World Dooars Utsav	 The 18th World Dooars Utsav was inaugurated to showcase the rich and diverse culture and heritage of the region, comprising tea gardens and dense forests. The festival highlights the unique and rich culture of the 26 tribal communities of the Dooars region to the world.
Migratory birds vanishing in Karala and Teesta rivers	Context: Migratory bird numbers along Karala and Teesta rivers in Jalpaiguri are declining due to pollution and illegal fishing. Oxygen levels are dropping as a consequence, impacting the food sources of migratory birds such as aquatic algae, insects, and small fish.
	 Key Points: Teesta River, passing by Jalpaiguri town, houses 271 bird species, including 107 migratory birds like the Golden-headed Cisticola and birds of prey such as Steppe Eagle, Eastern Imperial Eagle, Booted Eagle, Common Buzzard, Long-Legged Buzzard, and Short-Toed Snake Eagle.
