Financial Disbursement: A record amount of Rs 2347 crores has been disbursed under BMSSY over the last 12 years, starting from May 2011 when Mamata Banerjee assumed the role of Chief Minister. About: Bina Mulya Samajik Suraksha Yojana is the social security scheme of the West Bengal Government. It was launched in the year 2020. Earlier this scheme was known as "Samajik Suraksha Yojana (SSY) - 2017. But from the 1st of April 2020, the Government of West Bengal renamed the scheme name to "Bina Mulya Samajik Suraksha Yojana. This scheme is also called "Bina Mulya Samajik Suraksha Scheme" or "Bina Mulya Social Security Scheme". The main objective behind starting Bina Mulya Samajik Suraksha Yojana is to provide social security to Unorganised Sector Labour Workers and their families.
