Reintroduction of Spotted Deer in Buxa **Tiger Reserve** 

### Context:

- To enhance the biodiversity of the Buxa Tiger Reserve (BTR), a group of 52 spotted deer was recently introduced into the reserve.
- This effort is part of a long-standing project that has seen over 1000 deer reintroduced into the reserve over the past decade.
- The deer were sourced from the Bethuadahari Wildlife Sanctuary and successfully released into the core zone of BTR.

## **Buxa Tiger Reserve**

- Buxa Tiger Reserve (BTR) lies in the Alipurduar sub-division of the Jalpaiguri district of West Bengal.
- Its northern boundary runs along the international border with Bhutan.
- The Sinchula hill range lies all along the northern side of BTR and the Eastern boundary touches that of the Assam State.
- The Phipsu Wildlife Sanctuary of Bhutan is contiguous to the North of BTR.
- Manas National Park lies east of BTR.
- BTR, thus, serves as an international corridor for elephant migration between India and Bhutan.
- The reserve encompasses as many as eight forest types.
- The main flora species constitute trees like Sal, Champ, Gamar, Simul, and Chikrasi.
- The main fauna species include Asian elephants, Tiger, Gaur, Wild boar, Sambar, and wild dogs (Dhole).

Extension of 'Yogyashree' Project	<ul> <li>Context:</li> <li>Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee has expanded the scope of the 'Yogyashree' project to include general category students, offering them access to free coaching for competitive examinations.</li> <li>Originally targeted towards SC and ST students, the project now encompasses a broader demographic.</li> <li>Banerjee has directed the establishment of 50 additional centres across the state to facilitate this extension, emphasizing inclusivity in educational opportunities.</li> </ul>
Budgetary Allocation 2024-25	<ul> <li>The Bengal government plans to raise budget allocations significantly for social schemes like MGNREGA and Awas Yojana to offset fund shortages caused by delayed clearance from the Centre.</li> <li>Sources indicate a potential increase in budget allocation for the Awas Yojana scheme, which has been affected by withheld funds from the Centre, causing a backlog of around Rs 6,600 crore in dues for 11 lakh beneficiaries.</li> </ul>
