Bhutan, with a population of less than 800,000, has embraced democracy for 15 years and is renowned for its unique Gross National Happiness (GNH) index, measuring factors like recreation and emotional well-being.

Sultan Ibrahim of Johor state installed as Malaysia's 17th king

In a historic ceremony, **Sultan Ibrahim of Johor** state has been installed as **Malaysia's 17th king.** This event marks a significant moment in the nation's constitutional monarchy system, where the throne rotates among the rulers of the nine Malay states.

BRICS Welcomes New Members: Saudi Arabia, Egypt, UAE, Iran, and Ethiopia

Tamil Nadu Achieves Record with Highest Number of Ramsar Sites in India



Union Budget 2024-25: Nirmala Sitharaman's Focus on Economic Growth

On February 1, 2024, as part of the legislature's budget session, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman will deliver the **Union Budget 2024** for the fiscal year 2024–2025. However, due to it being an election year, the budget presented will be a temporary financial plan or a vote on account.

Government Cuts Import Duty on Phone Components Cut to 10% from 15%

In a strategic move to bolster the **mobile phone manufacturing industry in India**, the Centre has announced a significant reduction in import duties on mobile phone components. The import duty on parts used for mobile phone manufacturing has been slashed to **10% from the earlier 15%.** This decision aligns with India's broader objectives to enhance its role in global supply chains and increase exports.

India's Core Sector Growth Slumps to 14-Month Low at 3.8% in December 2023

India's core sector output growth plummeted to a **14-month low of 3.8% YoY** in December, as reported by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry. This sharp decline from the previous month's 7.9% was attributed to a high base and a slowdown in six constituent sectors. Notably, only fertilizers (5.8%) and cement (1.3%) sectors saw an output acceleration in December.

GST Collection Soars 10% in January to Record ₹1.72 Lakh Crore, Marking Second-Highest Ever

In a commendable financial feat, the Centre reported a **10.4% surge** in Goods and Services Tax (GST) revenue for January, reaching an impressive **₹1,72,129 crore.** This milestone represents the **second-highest GST collection ever** recorded, with the ₹1.7 lakh crore benchmark surpassed for the third time in the fiscal year 2023-24. The Ministry of Finance disclosed that the robust growth is indicative of a significant year-on-year increase,

showcasing a notable rise from the ₹1,55,922 crore collected in January 2023.

Union Budget 2024

In the Budget for the fiscal year 2024–25, the Union Government demonstrates a robust commitment to bolstering economic growth through substantial investments in infrastructure development. The total expenditure in the Budget is estimated at 47,65,768 crore(47.65 Lakh Crore), with a significant focus on capital expenditure, reaching 11,11,111 crore(11.11 Lakh Crore). This reflects a commendable increase of 16.9% in capital expenditure over the Revised Estimates (RE) for 2023–24.

Budget 2024: Bhutan Leads As Top Indian Aid Recipient The Interim Budget 2024, unveiled by Finance M<mark>iniste</mark>r Nirmala Sitharaman, sheds light on **India's** foreign aid allocation, with Bhutan emerging as a significant recipient. In the Financial Year 2024-25, India allocated a substantial portion of its budget to foreign aid, with a notable emphasis on Bhutan. The allocation for Bhutan underscores India's commitment to supporting its neighboring countries' development initiatives.

Govt Offers 'Bharat' Rice At ₹29/kg In Retail Market
In response to escalating rice prices, the
Government of India has unveiled the 'Bharat' brand
rice, aiming to address market volatility and ensure
affordability for consumers. he rice will be available
in 5- and 10-kg packs at ₹29 per kg through
cooperatives such as Nafed, NCCF, and Kendriya
Bhandar.

Record-Breaking UPI Transactions Hit ₹18.4 Trillion in January: NPCI Data

The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) reports a remarkable milestone in Unified Payment Interface (UPI) transactions for January, reaching a record ₹18.41 trillion. This marks a 52% increase in volume and a substantial 42% rise in value compared to the same month in the previous financial year.





RBI Announces: 97.50% of Rs 2,000 Notes Returned to System

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) revealed on February 1 that 97.50% of the Rs 2,000 currency notes in circulation as of May 19, 2023, have been successfully reintegrated into the banking system. This development follows the government's decision to withdraw the high-denomination bills as part of the clean note policy.

Under the SPA, Excelerate will secure up to one million tons per annum (MTPA) of LNG from QatarEnergy. The deliveries, set to commence from January 2026, will be directed to floating storage and regasification units in Bangladesh. The agreement encompasses Excelerate's procurement of 0.85 MTPA of LNG in 2026 and 2027, and one MTPA from 2028 to 2040.

WHO Honors Countries For The First Time For Eliminating Industrially Produced Trans Fats


