



<p><b>Bharat Ratna Awardees Announced</b></p>  <p>Bharat Ratna to Honor PV Narasimha Rao, Chaudhary Charan Singh, and MS Swaminathan</p>	<p><b>Context:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian honor, will be conferred upon three notable figures: <b>M.S. Swaminathan, P.V. Narasimha Rao, and Chaudhary Charan Singh.</b></li> <li>These individuals join the list of esteemed awardees, which includes <b>L.K. Advani and Karpoori Thakur</b>, making this year's tally the longest ever announced.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This year's announcement marks a record with <b>five Bharat Ratna awardees</b>, surpassing the previous highest count from 1999.</li> <li>Notably, four out of the five awards are being given <b>posthumously</b>.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Legislative Changes in Jammu and Kashmir</b></p>	<p><b>Context:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Rajya Sabha recently passed bills to include various communities into the <b>Scheduled Tribes (ST) and Scheduled Castes (SC) lists in Jammu and Kashmir.</b></li> <li>Among the amendments, the <b>Pahari ethnic group</b> was added to the <b>ST list</b>, addressing the ongoing protests by the <b>Gujjar-Bakarwal community.</b></li> <li>Additionally, the Bills incorporated the Paddari Tribe, Gadda Brahmin, and Koli communities into the <b>ST list.</b></li> <li>The Valmiki community, along with its synonyms, was included in the <b>SC list.</b></li> </ul>
<p><b>Indian Ocean Conference</b></p> 	<p><b>Context:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The 7th Indian Ocean Conference (IOC) 2024, was held on February 9-10, 2024, in <b>Perth, Australia.</b></li> <li><b>It was attended by representatives from 40 countries and Foreign Ministers from various regional nations participated in the event.</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Conference Objectives:</b></p> <p>The primary focus of the conference was to facilitate discussions on regional cooperation and propose solutions concerning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Regional security</b></li> <li><b>Economic development</b></li> <li><b>Environmental protection</b></li> <li><b>Maritime safety within the Indian Ocean region.</b></li> </ul>
