- Tangail saris are known for fine craftsmanship and are woven in the Nadia and Purba Bardhaman districts.
- Korial saris feature heavy gold and silver embellishments on a white or cream base, akin to Benarasi saris.
- Garad silk saris are plain white or off-white with unornamental colored borders, traditionally worn during pujas.

- The Howrah Maidan-Esplanade section, an innovative addition to Kolkata's transport network, features the deepest metro station in India at Howrah Metro Station.
- The East-West Metro corridor, spanning 4.8 km from Howrah Maidan to Esplanade, was built for Rs 4,965 crore.
- The project, which began in 2009, faced delays due to various challenges, including an aquifer burst at Bowbazar in central Kolkata in 2019, leading to ground subsidence and building collapses.

State forest dept plans a tiger exchange programme

Context:

- The state forest department is planning a tiger exchange program among various zoos under the State Zoo Authority.
- The program aims to enhance genetic diversity in captive-bred tigers.

Key points:

- Two Royal Bengal tigers were recently moved from Bengal Safari Park in Siliguri to Alipore Zoo in Kolkata. In return, a female tiger will be sent to Bengal Safari Park.
- Similar tiger exchanges are planned for other zoos, such as Padmaja Naidu Zoological Park in Darjeeling.
- West Bengal currently has 12 zoos, and the forest department intends to exchange tigers among these facilities.
- Bengal Safari Park currently houses nine tigers, including five males and two cubs.
- The arrival of the female tiger from Alipore Zoo aims to introduce a fresh bloodline.
