



West Bengal News



Context:

- Purulia district has achieved 100% enrollment of the Birhor tribe residing in villages around the Ayodhya Hills.
- There are 313 Birhor tribe members in remote villages in Bagmundi block, out of which 181 are eligible to vote.

About:

- The Birhor tribe is a tribal forest community, traditionally nomadic, primarily found Jharkhand.
- They speak the **Birhor language**, which belongs to the Munda group of languages of the Austroasiatic language family.
- Some Birhor tribespeople are also found in Odisha. Chhattisgarh, and West Bengal.
- The total population of the Birhor tribe is approximately 10,000, according to the last census, although some sources suggest that their numbers may have decreased over the years.
- The Birhor tribe continues to pursue a "primitive subsistence economy" based on nomadic gathering and hunting, especially for monkeys.

Station Walls Barrackpore Railway Transformed into Colorful Homage to History & Culture




Context:
