	About:  Adenoviruses are common viruses that typically cause a mild cold- or flu-like illness.  Adenoviruses can cause illness in people of all ages at any time of year.  Adenoviruses can cause a wide range of illnesses including  common cold- or flu-like symptoms  fever  sore throat  pink eye (conjunctivitis)  acute bronchitis (inflammation of the airways of the lungs, sometimes called  a "chest cold")  pneumonia (infection of the lungs, occasionally severe)  diarrhea  acute gastroenteritis (inflammation of the stomach or intestines causing  diarrhea, vomiting, nausea, and stomach pain)
	<ul> <li>There is no specific treatment or approved antiviral medicine for people</li> <li>with adenovirus infection.</li> </ul>
