Darjeeling Zoo releases four zoo-bred Himalayan Gorals in Singalila National Park



Context:

• The Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park (Pnhzp), also known as the Darjeeling Zoo, has taken another step in its conservation efforts by releasing two pairs of zoo-bred Himalayan Gorals into the Singalila National Park.

Key points:

- Previously, in 2022, the Pnhzp had introduced six zoo-bred Gorals into the Mahananda Wildlife Sanctuary.
- The Singalila National Park, situated on the Singalila Ridge at an elevation of over 2,300 meters above sea level in the Darjeeling district, is renowned for its trekking route to Sandakphu.
- It is recognized as a biodiversity hotspot, boasting a rich variety of flora and fauna.

Himalayan Gorals:

- The Himalayan goral (Naemorhedus goral), also known as the gray goral, is native to the Himalayas and is classified as near threatened on the IUCN Red List.
- It typically measures between 95 and 130 cm in length and weighs between 35 and 42 kg.
- The animal's appearance includes a gray or gray-brown coat with tan legs, lighter patches on the throat, and a single dark stripe along the spine.
- Currently, there are 33 Himalayan Gorals at the Pnhzp.

Bengal Ranks Second in Political Party **Applications**

Context:

- West Bengal has secured the second position in the country regarding requests made by political parties through the Suvidha portal for various purposes such as booking rally grounds, opening temporary party offices, and operating video publicity vans.
- The state has received approximately 13,890 requests as of the latest report till Monday.
- Tamil Nadu leads with the highest number of requests at 23,239, followed by West Bengal and Madhya Pradesh with 10,636 requests.

Suvidha Portal:	 The Suvidha Portal, developed by the Election Commission of India (ECI), is a technological solution aimed at ensuring fair and transparent elections, in line with democratic principles. It simplifies the process of requesting and processing permissions and facilities for political parties and candidates during elections. The portal operates on a first-in-in-first-out basis, catering to a wide range of permission requests transparently. Political parties and candidates can easily submit permission requests online from anywhere and at any time. Offline submission options are also available to ensure inclusivity. The Suvidha Portal handles permissions for various activities such as rallies, temporary party offices, door-to-door canvassing, video vans, helicopters, vehicle permits, and pamphlet distribution. Managed by nodal officers from different state departments, the portal uses a robust IT platform to efficiently process permission requests. It also offers a companion app that allows applicants to track the status of their requests in real time, enhancing convenience and transparency. Additionally, the permission data available on the portal is a valuable resource for monitoring election expenditures, promoting greater accountability and integrity in the electoral process.
Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) of West Bengal	 Arnab Chatterjee has been appointed as the new Joint Chief Electoral Officer in the office of the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) of West Bengal. Chatterjee, a WBCS officer, previously served as the Joint Secretary in the School Education department. His appointment comes after the recent removal of Rahul Nath, the previous Joint Chief Electoral Officer, by the poll panel. Additionally, Amit Roy Chowdhury, the Additional Chief Electoral Officer, was also removed from his position. In Roy Chowdhury's place, Dibyendu Das, the former director of the West Bengal Transport Department, has been appointed.




